





At the age of six, Mony Nop and his family escaped the reign of terror of the Khmer Rouge and the killing fields of Cambodia only to end up in hard scrabble refugee camps in Thailand and the Phillipines. He arrived in the U.S. at the age of ten and ended up dumpster diving for food. With much hard work, determination, and resourcefulness, he began his journey to success. He eventually became a police officer for 16 years and later went on to be a realtor and a Rotarian.
