NEXT MEETING: "AVOIDING SCAMS"



♦ October 6: Old friend Oak Dowling will be our speaker. His presentation is entitled: Avoiding Scams-Including Covid, Fraud, and Identity Theft. Oak will enlighten and educate us on how to protect older adults and all ages against common financial scams. A 2018 study asserts that financial elder abuse costs \$36.5 billion annually. In Marin County alone, financial abuse cases make up 32% of all referrals to Adult Protective Services. Nationwide it's estimated that only one in 10 cases is reported.
