JUNE 30: HITLER'S GREAT GAMBLE

♦ James Ellman, author of *Hitler's Great Gamble*, will be our speaker. He will present a surprising explanation for how and why Hitler lost World War II. On June 22, 1941, Hitler invaded the Soviet Union in Operation Barbarossa, one of the turning points of World War II. Within six months, the invasion bogged down on the outskirts of Moscow, and the Eastern Front proved to be the decisive theater in the defeat of the Third Reich. Ever since, most historians have agreed that this was Hitler's gravest mistake. In *Hitler's Great Gamble*, Ellman argues that while Barbarossa was a gamble and perverted by genocidal Nazi ideology, it was not doomed from the start. History buffs will love this program.
