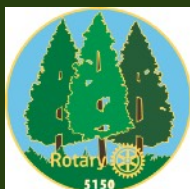

ROTARY IN THE WORLD

❖ President Lisán has regularly been emphasizing Rotary's role Around the World. This week she tackled the subject of eradicating Polio in Pakistan, where vaccines are seen as a low priority since there is an abundance of trash, open sewers and contaminated water. She noted that combatting that problem is being done by the construction of water filtration plants (36 since 2012) so families

who come to get clean water can also bring their children to be vaccinated. The idea is to build

trust between local populations and stake holders.

PROGRAM

❖ Dr. Joan Steidinger, in her presentation entitled *The Notion of Equality in Sports*, noted that traditionally "sports" was a man's domain. Title IX has strongly changed this landscape in terms of participation in sports by girls and women. More than ever men and women have daughters who participate and excel in sports.

However, she explained, when women went on to pursue careers in sport, they discovered narrow and limited positions available for them in sports leadership, pay, media, and coaching. In her presentation she discussed both the improvements and limitations in sports for girls and women.

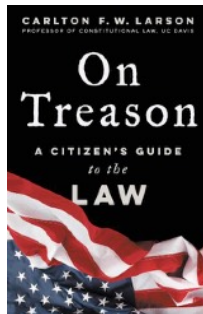
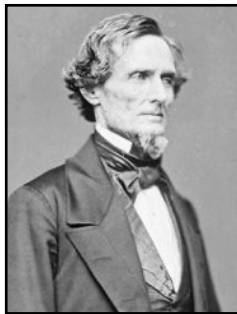
